2025 Annual Report

- In total, there are currently 109 individuals on the internal wait list in the Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area. 58 of the individuals are age 18 and older.
- There are 51 individuals on the comprehensive wait list for the area who are under age 18; therefore, personal care services (PCS) would be the only type of funding available to them. Several over the age of 18 would also only choose personal care services if funding was offered (rather than agency residential services).
- Currently, individuals who have been on the wait list through 9/30/2017 have been offered funding by KDADS. Individuals placed on the wait list on 10/01/2017 and after are still waiting. Even though the State sent out a lot of wait-list offers in 2025, individuals still continue to wait over 8 years to come off the wait list for IDD waiver funding.
- 26 individuals from the Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area were removed from the wait list in 2025.
 - Voluntary removal (moved out of the catchment area, moved out of state, no longer needing/wanting services, or death) – 4 individuals
 - HCBS funding offered and accepted – 13 individuals
 - HCBS funding offered and declined – 3 individuals
 - HCBS funding offered, but no response/unable to locate – 3 individuals
 - HCBS funded through crisis/exception funding – 3 individuals
 - HCBS funding offered but financially ineligible – 0 individuals

*10 individuals were added to the wait list in this CDDO area in 2025.
