Annual Report 2019

Arrowhead West, Inc. is the CDDO for 13 counties in southwest Kansas.

In May of 2019 we had a successful CDDO peer review.

\*In total there are currently 113 individuals on the internal wait list in Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area.

\*There are 6 individuals on the comprehensive internal wait list who are currently receiving some I/DD service through private pay/sliding fee scale. This is a significant decrease over the past 2 years as several who had been on sliding fee scale were funded from the wait list in 2018 and 2019.

\*There are 55 individuals on the comprehensive wait list who are under age 18; therefore personal care services (PCS) would be the only type of funding available to them. Several over the age of 18 would also only choose PCS if funding was offered (rather than agency residential services).

\*There is no longer an “underserved” category. If a person has some type of HCBS I/DD funding and they desire additional services or a change in type of services, the request is made to the MCO. The MCO will then evaluate and approve/deny the requested service.

\*Currently individuals that have been on the wait list through 11/01/2011 have been funded by KDADS. Individuals placed on the wait list 11/02/2011 or after are still waiting. Therefore, individuals continue to wait OVER 8 years to come off of the state’s wait list!

\*19 individuals from the Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area were removed from the wait list in 2019. Ten were offered funding from the wait list – 9 accepted funding and 1 did not respond to the offer.

\*3 individuals from the catchment area were approved for crisis funding.

\*12 new individuals were added to the wait list.
