Annual Report 2020

- In total there are currently 118 individuals on the internal wait list in Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area.
- There are 56 individuals on the comprehensive wait list who are under age 18; therefore personal care services (PCS) would be the only type of funding available to them. Several over the age of 18 would also only choose PCS if funding was offered (rather than agency residential services).
- There is no longer an “underserved” category. If a person has some type of HCBS I/DD funding and they desire additional services or a change in type of services, the request is made to the MCO. The MCO will then evaluate and approve/deny the requested service.
- Currently individuals that have been on the wait list through 11/02/2011 have been funded by KDADS. Individuals placed on the wait list 11/03/2011 or after are still waiting. Therefore, individuals continue to wait OVER 9 years to come off of the state’s wait list!
- 14 individuals from the Arrowhead West CDDO catchment area were removed from this CDDO’s wait list in 2020. Most (8) of these removals were due to the individual moving out of the catchment area. Only 2 received new HCBS funding – 1 through a crisis funding request and 1 as an exception (transition out of foster care at age 18). No individual in AWI catchment area was offered funding from the wait list in 2020.
- 11 new individuals were added to the wait list.
